On "RADIO AWAJ" our listeners are ranging from 1.25 lakhs to 3.0 lakhs. This is the first of its kind radio service in Dahod District. Our main motto is to bring awareness among the community members about education, health, law, blind faith and citizens rights & duties. During the Covid 19 Pandemic we raised good amount awareness among the people of Dahod district by giving several programs and discussions.

We have organized several programs for the awareness for the rights of persons with disabilities, Parents guidance and awareness program, electronic voting system, guidance and awareness about various Laws.

In the coming year we need to construct a separate building for the Lions Divyang Talim Center for persons with disabilities. I earnestly, request all of you to extend your wholehearted support and co-operation for raising funds for this center.

I avail this opportunity to express my feelings of gratitude towards all in-house and field staff and our trustees who have continuously been working with extra ordinary zeal and examplary devotion. The Organization has been moving forward towards the achievement of its mission. Gradually they understood the work of this organization and registered themselves with the organization.

This organization is working for education, training, sports training, rehabilitation and financial support to persons with disabilities. So that they can live a life with respect and dignity in the society. Talking about the sports activities let us know about the sports persons of this area.

A vision towards the life of the athletes with disabilities in the Tribal Area. Today many athletes from Dahod, Panchmahal and Mahisagar districts are able to change their lives.

The credit goes to the special teachers of the institute, the sports teachers, as well as the staff of every department working in the institute. Due to the hard work, dedication and selfless spirit of these employees, these athletes achieved a prominent position in the society.

Whether it is district level, state level, national level or international level, when the athletes are selected for any game, the task of training them, preparing their documents, all the staff members of the organization work hard with good coordination.

As a result our athletes are able to participate in special olympics at International level. The athletes with disabilities of this tribal area have been able to shine in different games. It is matter of great pride for the organization, the community and our country, as these athletes have won medals at international level.

An excellent example is of the World Summer Games organised by Special Olympics in June 2023 at Berlin Germany. In which a total of 03 athletes with intellectual disabilities living in rural areas participated and these 03 athletes together won 04 medals. The details of which are as follows.

Programmes / Activities of the Organisation

Latit BathuDiwang Wivasi Paathshaala (For the children with intellectual disabilities and multiple disabilities) & Residential School for Children with Hearing Impairment

The Multiple disabled residential school run by BWC Dahod was first of its kind in Gujarat. At present there are 102 children with multiple disabilities, out of which 69 are boys and 33 are girls. They stay in the hostel and get systematic training and education. The teachers are specially qualified and are imparting best quality education and training to the special children. The development is slow but constant. The students with hearing impairment are provided training with help of sign language, charts, and models. The number of teachers provided by the Government is few, but the Trust has appointed adequate number of teachers at its own cost and is trying to provide best services to the children. All these students are provided education, lodging and boarding free of cost.

Day Care Center for the children with Intelletental Disabilities & Multiple Disabilities

The institution is having a Day care center for children with intellectual disabilities and multiple disabilities, Where in we have 30 boys and 22 girls with the total of 52 such children who are imparted training and education during the day. The children go back to home in the evening. Our teachers work very hard for the all round development of these children.

In both above set ups we do not charge any fees form the students. All the services are provided free of cost.

RADIO AWAIJ908 FWI—Community Radio Station

With the kind Permission from Ministry of Information and Broadcasting along with six other ministries, on 5th October 2018, we have added one more developmental service for the community. We have started with Community Radio services on 90.8 FM named "RADIO AWAJ". This is the first of its kind radio service in Dahod District.

Our aim is to provide maximum awareness to all citizens in all developmental fields. We broadcast several programs on health, education, general awareness, developmental activities, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Information on schemes from Social Defence department for the rights and duties of persons with disabilities, success stories of eminent persons and several programs on entertainment including new and old film songs are also being broadcasted. Special programs are relayed on different festivals celebrated at our institution. We also invite school students and teachers to express their views about community radio and we organize different competitions as per their level.

We are reaching to the community directly live, with mobile app (Radio Awaj Dahod) and with the help of Radio Garden (online). We have reached to about 1.25 lakh listeners by now. During the Covid 19 Pandemic we raised remarkable awareness among the people of Dahod district with several programs and discussions. At that time we had reached to about 3 lakh listeners.

We have received good support from Government departments and Public for the successful operation of this Community Radio Station. We expect the same support in future also.

IEDSS ((Inclusive eEducation for Disabbed Children at Secondary Stage)

We are running this program with the help of the Government of India and the IEDSS cell based at SSA: Samagra Siksha Abhiyan Gandhinagar. Here we cover disabled children with different categories from Std 1st - 12th. (Intellectual disabled, Hearing impaired, Visually impaired, locomotor disabled). These children study in the normal school of their own villages. Our special teachers who are trained in that particular category teach these children and provide all the special training needed as per the ability of the student. They also help them to get all kinds of Government and Non Government benefits. In this program our special teachers cover the following children with disabilities.

Industrial Training Center (I.T.C.)

With a mission of training the persons with disabilities and to enable them to earn a livelihood with respect and dignity, the institute is running Industrial training center (ITC) from last 16 Years, where in a Computer Operator course is being conducted. Several beneficiaries have undergone training in this course. Immediately after this course they are able to get a job or get self employed.

Early Intervention & Sensory Training

Under this program we identify disabled children from 0-6 years. An assessment of abilities and disabilities of these children is done and accordingly early intervention plans and counseling program are framed and implemented. By this programme the abilities of the child can be improved to a great extent. So that as the child grows older he can have less trouble to perform his daily activities. At present about 10 children are benefitting from this programme.

The sensory stimulation of all five senses of these children is done in our sensory integration room and sensory garden.

Lions Diwang Talim Center:

With a mission to provide training and employment to young disabled people, we have started with Lions Divyang Talim Center - Training & Production center:

- 1. Computer operating training
- 2. Offset printing & screen printing
- 3. Stitching & Embroidery work
- 4. Paper Dish Making
- 5. Carpentry & Furniture making

- 6. File Making
- 7. Computerized Braille Printing
- 8. Door mate making
- 9. Candle & Chalk Stick making

Persons with special needs are getting trained in the above trades and have started earning for their living.
